AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PREVAILING WAGE RATES

WHEREAS the State of Illinois has enacted “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, codified as amended, 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq. (1993), formerly ILL. Rev. Stat., Ch 48, Par.39s-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS the aforementioned Act requires the Village of Carbon Cliff to investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of Rock Island County employed in performing construction of public works, for said Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carbon Cliff, Illinois:

SECTION ONE: To the extent and as required by “An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics and Other Workers employed in any Public Works by the State, County, City or any Public Body or any Political Subdivision or by any one under contract for Public Works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of Public Works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Carbon Cliff is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in Rock Island County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of July 1, 2015, a copy of that determination being attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION TWO: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Carbon Cliff to the extent required by the aforementioned Act.

SECTION THREE: The Village of Carbon Cliff shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village Clerk this determination or any revision of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

SECTION FOUR: The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such wage rates.

SECTION FIVE: The Village Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with *both* the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION SIX: The Village Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area, a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

SECTION SEVEN: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
