

BOIL ORDER NOTICE – EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

July 19, 2020

The Water Operator for the Village of Carbon Cliff has issued a precautionary boil order for properties located in the downtown area. All properties along RT 84 (2nd Avenue) from Colona Road to I-5, all of 1st Avenue from 6th Street to State Street, 1st Street through 6th Street; State Street, Lily Avenue, Jay Street, and Sinclair Boulevard.

The village is currently working on repairing a water main break. The village is asking that you please boil your water before drinking and cooking. This is simply a precautionary measure put in place by the state of Illinois, the Federal Environmental Protection Agency, and the Village of Carbon Cliff. This Boil Order will continue to stay in place until all repairs are completed, and the approved EPA tests come back clear, at which time the Village shall issue a Release of Boil Order Notice.
